I'm very pleased that You will continue for the next fraternal year as chief editor for our newsletter.

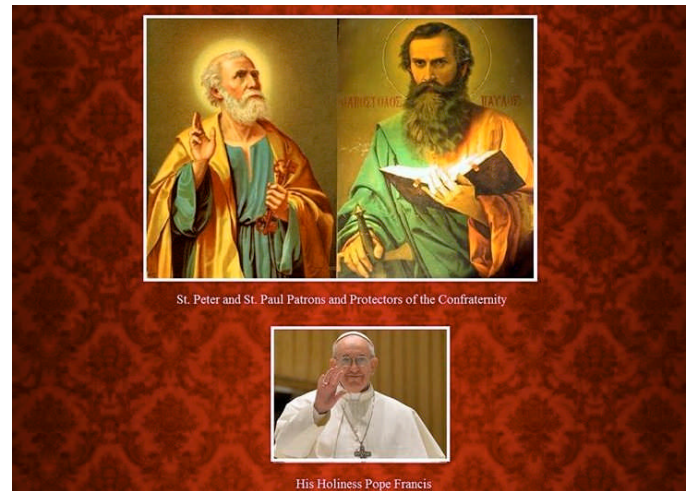

During the celebration the Pope conferred the pallium on new Metropolitan Archbishops, including Archbishop Christian Lépine of Montreal, Archbishop Luc Cyr of Sherbrooke, Archbishop Paul-André Durocher of Gatineau and Archbishop Valéry Vienneau of Moncton (who will receive his pallium upon his installation on August 29).

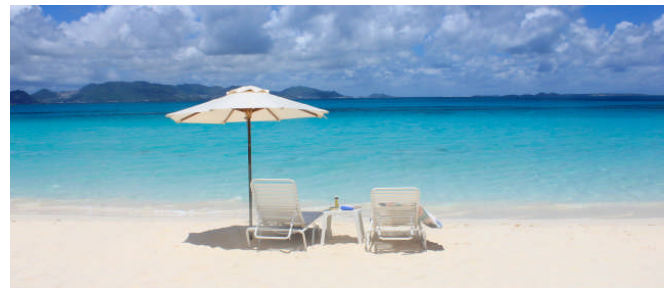
